

Beatrice Campanella is a permanent researcher at ICCOM-CNR in Pisa, where her research focuses on atomic and molecular spectroscopy, chromatography, and sample preparation. She obtained her MSc (2013) and PhD (2016) in Analytical Chemistry from the University of Pisa, with a doctoral thesis focused on the analysis of inorganic contaminants. During her post-doctoral fellowship in the Applied Laser Spectroscopy group at ICCOM-CNR, she broadened her expertise to LIBS and SERS, particularly for cultural heritage applications, a research area she continues to pursue alongside studies in toxicology. Since 2015, she has also collaborated with the National Research Council Canada on the development of isotope-dilution GC-MS methods for Certified Reference Materials. She is the author of more than 100 scientific publications and has an H-index of 29 and over 2,500 citations (SCOPUS).
