He holds a degree in Nuclear Engineering from the Polytechnic University of Turin (1987) and a PhD in Condensed Matter Physics/Nanotechnology.

He is a Full Professor of Condensed Matter Physics at the Polytechnic University of Turin, where he founded the Materials and Microsystems Labs in 1999 and coordinated the international Master's program in Micro- and Nano-technologies for ICT from 2002 to 2019. He has been a member of the Electronic, Telecommunications, and Physics (ETF) Engineering Board since 2015 and serves as Vice-Rector for the Development of Research Models and Infrastructure.

Since 2018, he has served as Director of the Center for Sustainable Future Technologies (CSFT)—part of the Italian Institute of Technology—located at the Environment Park in Turin. The CSFT is dedicated to global scientific and technological efforts aimed at addressing sustainability challenges, primarily reducing the anthropogenic CO₂ footprint and improving the efficiency of alternative energy and raw material utilization.
