

Giovanna Schiavoni is Senior Researcher at the Department of Oncology and Molecular Medicine, Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS), Rome, Italy. Her research focuses on tumor immunology and cancer immunotherapy, with particular interest in the tumor microenvironment, melanoma, immune regulation, the IL-33/ST2 axis, eosinophils, dendritic cells, and type I interferons. She has been Principal Investigator of several nationally and internationally funded research projects, including AIRC and Next Generation EU–PNRR grants. She is a founding member of the Italian Society of Organ-on-Chip and serves as Associate Editor and reviewer for several international journals in cancer and immunology. She has authored 66 scientific publications and book chapters, with an H-index of 35.
